

**VENDOR'S CODE OF ETHICS
FOR
ROSE CITY EXOTIC BIRD CLUB EXPO EVENTS**

Vendors will provide clean and safe cages to display their birds in. Cages must not be overcrowded to the point of it becoming a health hazard for the birds in that cage.

Vendors will provide an adequate amount of food and clean fresh water for their birds while at the sale. This means making sure that there is enough food and water for all the birds housed in your booth at all times.

Vendors will not display sick or injured birds or bring sick or injured birds onto the premises. If a bird becomes sick or injured at the Expo and you can not remove it immediately contact the Expo Manager or ask for assistance at the Club Table.

Vendors will keep in mind the health and well being of their birds before anything else. If we find your birds are being treated inhumanely you will be asked to leave the sale and no refund will be made.

Vendors will treat other vendors and Rose City Exotic Bird Club with respect. No 'bad-mouthing' of other vendors or Rose City Exotic Bird Club to customers or other vendors will be allowed. If you have a problem you would like to voice, please come to the club table for assistance.

Judgement of whether or not there is a violation of one of the above listed items will be made by a quorum of Rose City Exotic Bird Club's Board of Directors. If any one vendor has been reprimanded for any of the above and that vendor does not comply, whether it be at the same show he/she was reprimanded at or at any future shows, the vendor may not be allowed to return again. All decisions made by Rose City Exotic Bird Club's Board of Directors will be final.
